Its courses, linked to the latest scientific advances, are supported by the activity of leading-edge research laboratories, backed by large industrial groups, ranging from new materials for aeronautics, environmental sciences to Nano-objects. The international dimension is a priority for INSA: mandatory 12 week period abroad for all students, 120 agreements worldwide and more than 10 international programs. Health insurance requirements and costs	Do you required students to have a health insurance? YES it's compulsory if you stay more than 2 months and if you don't have the European card of health insurance, you must take the assurance at our administrative registration: it costs 200 € for your stay. In addition, you must take in your country a international medical insurance certificate translated into French or English, valid 2 months after your arrival.
Accommodation:	Internationals Relations Direction manages the booking of your accommodation with our 2 partners: CROUS and PROMOLOGIS.
