### Entry requirements

- Minimum one year of bachelor-level study at a Higher Education Institution
- Minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA where the maximum GPA is 4.0, or 7.0 GPA where the maximum is 10.0
- English Language proficiency: minimum IELTS 6.5 equivalent
