 - Undergraduate, Graduate, and Intensive English Language Exchange Options
- Undergraduate/ Graduate Application for Admission to UGA (no application fee)
 - Student must be in good standing and recommended by home university
- Official transcript or grade report in English from home university
- TOEFL or IELTS score report
 - TOEFL 550 (paper), 80 (iBT), 214 (CBT), 6.5 (IELTS)
- Medical History and Immunization Forms
- Course Request Form
- On-Campus Housing Application (online after acceptance)
- Copy of Passport (submit with online DS-2019 Request Form after acceptance)
- Certificate of Finances
 - Submit upon request after acceptance
