

Syllabus of NTU Enhancing Course

Elementary

Course Goal	The course focuses on the trainings of listening and speaking. Capable of communicating with basic vocabularies and grammar, making a self-introduction and dealing with daily issues such as ordering meals, asking directions, making requests and leaving a message, etc.
Course Description	This course helps students to brush up the listening and speaking skills that enable them of effective daily conversations.
Target Students	For those who are taking Elementary I, II and III of NTU General Chinese Language Course.
Weekly course content, grading and other class regulations and requirements will be decided by the teachers who are giving the course.	

Intermediate

Course Goal	Capable of giving an oral report and writing a short essay upon common societal topics, such as climate, history and culture, politics and economics, sports and entertainments, tourism, etc. Capable of understanding and write articles of advertisements and leaflets.
Course Description	This course helps students to learn commonly used new vocabularies and grammar that are not often used in daily conversations. Through the course, students will be able to use appropriate Chinese language to carry on discussions and understand commonly used writings and articles.
Target Students	For those who are taking Intermediate I, II and III of NTU General Chinese Language Course.
Weekly course content, grading and other class regulations and requirements will be decided by the teachers who are giving the course.	

Advanced

Course Goal	Capable of expressing oneself and making discussions fluently through the discussions of specific articles and topics. Capable of reading magazines and newspapers which contains difficult vocabularies and special sentence structures.
Course Description	This course does not use a specific textbook, but will bring up topics by the class that will help students develop proficiency in listening, speaking, reading and writing. Through the course, students will be able to use appropriate Chinese to carry on discussions, and read newspapers and magazines to further understand Taiwanese culture and language.
Target Students	For those who are taking Advanced of NTU General Chinese Language Course.
Weekly course content, grading and other class regulations and requirements will be decided by the teachers who are giving the course.
