


This publication provides overall data on student global engagement at the University of Georgia. It is organized by college and school to provide baseline information for units as they evaluate and expand global education and experiential learning opportunities for students. Information on study abroad programs, OGE allocations, scholarships, and credit hour generation is included to provide a holistic understanding of the numerous dimensions of the study abroad experience.

In the 2018 – 2019 academic year, the Global Education Office developed new services and resources for advisors and academic units. These include:


- Targeted Training & Development sessions for advisors, faculty, and staff that count towards the Global Certificate
- New outreach initiatives to promote participation of underrepresented students in study abroad in partnership with on-campus units
- The development of the Embedded program model to create more accessibility points for students interested in study abroad
- Additional support mechanisms for faculty and staff running study abroad programs, including:
  - targeted advertising and marketing campaigns to promote student enrollment;
  - online Risk Management workshops; and
  - hiring a dedicated staff member for faculty-led program coordination.





#### **UGA Programs Abroad Enrollment by** Ethnicity/Race





## **UGA Enrollment by Ethnicity/Race**
























# DOMESTIC FIELD STUDY ENGAGEMENT: OVERVIEW


In 2018, the Office of International Education transitioned into an oversight role for UGA's existing domestic programming. To reflect this expanded global portfolio, OIE was renamed the Office of Global Engagement (OGE). Nearly 50 domestic field study programs are offered through OGE, with over 30 running in 2018. These are designed and led by faculty across 7 of UGA's colleges and provide hands-on, site-specific work in 20 distinct locations throughout the southeast, the midwest, the east coast, and along the west coast. From arts-focused internships in Los Angeles to studying marine life in Key Largo, Florida, domestic field study offerings span the diversity of the student experience at UGA.


Through OGE, UGA's field study programs now provide participating students with:


- Academic advisors

- Online program evaluations and student feedback


