Incoming Exchange Student Application Materials

1. Online OGE StudyAway Exchange Program Application
 - Undergraduate, Graduate, and Intensive English Language Exchange Options
2. Undergraduate/ Graduate Application for Admission to UGA (no application fee)
 - Student must be in good standing and recommended by home university
3. Official transcript or grade report in English from home university
4. TOEFL or IELTS score report
 - TOEFL 550 (paper), 80 (iBT), 214 (CBT), 6.5 (IELTS)
5. Medical History and Immunization Forms
6. Copy of Passport
7. Course Request Form
8. On-Campus Housing Application, if desired (online after acceptance)
9. DS-2019 request for J-1 visa (submit upon request after acceptance)

Fall Semester ➔ February 15 Nomination ➔ March 15 Application
Spring Semester ➔ September 15 Nomination ➔ October 15 Application
